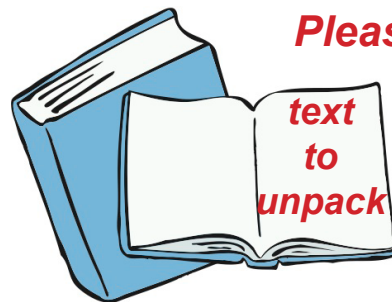
Integrating the big 6 within your literacy block
